The search resulted in eight surveys observing the prescribed criteria. The knowledge and contribution of midwives in most articles shows that they don't feel confident about their knowledge, whether the screening should be done routinely, who should give advice to pregnant women and explain the main features of Down syndrome. Researchers even studied whether pregnant women were fulfilled by the information they got from professionals - midwives but also the influence of the fulfillment of midwives with the knowledge and services they provide to pregnant women.
